**Welcome** to Camerata Nova's 2012-2013 season and programming, which includes the full Vespers by Monteverdi—a monumental work from 1610—to music so new that it hasn't been written yet! And to make this all happen, they will partner with exceptional soloists, singer-songwriters and instrumentalists.

But first, the group will offer its traditional free holiday concert as well as a special performance in connection with the Manitoba Hydro Santa Claus Parade. Enjoy a light holiday concert in the Atrium of the Manitoba Hydro Building on **Saturday, November 17th from 2:30 to 3:30 pm**. This free performance features Christmas classics, previews of our full holiday concert, plus a LIVE version of Camerata Nova's celebrated Winnipeg Jets Chant. Manitoba Hydro's own Electric Chords choir will join us in the sing-along portion of the concert and fire up the crowd!

Our first full concert of the season, *Manitoba Hydro Presents: Christmas in Early America*, features Christmas songs from the Americas—tradition with a twist. It will be presented in late November at Crescent Fort Rouge. We then go to Westminster in early April for the *The Full Monte, Vespers of 1610 by Monteverdi*, to be performed in full for the first time in Winnipeg.



To close out the season in May, we joins forces with renowned musicians John K. Samson, Christine Fellows, Gérald Laroche and the Correction Line Ensemble to present *Troubadours & Tricksters*.
