


Camerata Nova Celebrates with Harp and...Spoons!

On Saturday, November 30 at 8:00 pm and Sunday, December 1 at 3:00 pm, Camerata Nova performs its 17th annual <u>FREE</u> Christmas concert, sponsored

by Manitoba Hydro, at **Crescent Fort Rouge United Church**. Conductors Ross Brownlee and Michael McKay have put together an exciting and eclectic array of music, ranging from early Russian motets to Benjamin Britten, and Métis music!

True to the mission of Camerata Nova, *Noël of the North* is all about collaborations. Harpist Grace Cloutier from New York City will join us to perform exceptional harp/choir arrangements. Flautist Haley Rempel will also take part in the show. In addition, the group will perform stunning Slavic motets provided to us by The Rose Ensemble of Minneapolis. Also, in keeping with our five-year tradition, we have invited Sid Robinovitch, Andrew Balfour and Michael McKay to each write their own adaptation of a well-known carol – this time, it's *The Little Drummer Boy!*

Camerata Nova has launched its first new album since 2007! At the suggestion of many of our fans, we are issuing *Camerata Nova Live: Christmas in Early America*, a CD of last year's highly popular holiday concert, recorded by CBC Radio 2. It contains 19 tracks of early and contemporary American music, ranging from late 18th-century shape-note songs to very recent arrangements of Christmas carols. CDs will be sold for \$15 (\$12 for subscribers) at our concerts as well as at McNally Robinson Booksellers, Librairie À la page, Winnipeg Folk Festival Music Store and others.



Individual subscriptions for 2013-2014 are \$50 (adults), \$45 (seniors) and \$20 (students), and buddy subscriptions (two tickets to each concert) are \$95, \$85 and \$35. Subscribers get three concerts at an amazing discount price. You also are ensured prime seating (when available) and can buy Camerata Nova products at a reduced price, including this year's special presentation by Les Voix humaines. Plus, the group is a member of Musicnet, which entitles our subscribers to a "buy one get one free" ticket offer to one concert hosted by each of the other Musicnet members.
