Welcome to Camerata Nova's 2013-2014 season, which runs the gamut from a Christmas musical journey to a collaboration with Vince Fontaine's Indian City band. There is truly something for everyone this season!

To kick off the season, the group will offer its traditional free holiday concert as well as a special performance in connection with the Winnipeg Santa Claus Parade. Enjoy a light holiday concert in the Atrium of the Manitoba Hydro Building on Saturday, November 16th from 2:30 to 3:30 pm. The free performance includes holiday classics as well as a taste of our Christmas concert.

Our first full concert of the season, *Noël of the North*, features Christmas music from northern countries with New York harpist Grace Cloutier. The repertoire will be sometimes serious, sometimes fun, most times unexpected and always beautiful! Audience members are invited to perform with us in our **Spoon Choir** (spoons will be available at the door). It will be presented on November 30 and December 1 at Crescent Fort Rouge United Church.

February finds us back at Crescent Fort Rouge as Camerata Nova plays host for a concert by **Les Voix humaines**, entitled *Perchance to Dreame*. This internationally renowned ensemble from Montréal will be in Winnipeg for one concert only on February 4th. Our

March 8 and 9 concert features top Canadian early music master **Christopher Jackson** conducting the group for *Where's Gesualdo?* Learn more about Carlo Gesualdo, the maverick Italian Renaissance nobleman/composer/murderer, during a pre-concert talk. **NOTE:** The talk will take place in the hall on the 2nd floor of Crescent Fort Rouge, which is not accessible by elevator.

We wind up the season with a single performance of *Red White & Unplugged*. Camerata Nova will team up with Vince Fontaine and his new band **Indian City** for an acoustic concert that pushes the boundaries of traditional and contemporary Aboriginal music. **NOTE:** *Red & White Unplugged* will be presented Thursday May 15, 2014 only, at The Garrick Centre.


